Frieda Matilda Ranney

Age 87, of Minneapolis, passed away on Thursday, April 22, 2010 at the Minnesota Veterans Home in Minneapolis, Minnesota. Frieda was born and raised in Mountain Lake, Minnesota, the youngest of six children. After graduating from Kletzing College, University Park, Iowa, she was a schoolteacher for three years. She married Robert Ranney on August 26, 1949. Their union produced three sons and many lasting memories over 57 years, ending only with Bob's death in 2006. Together they founded Grace Baptist Church on the south side of Chicago as missionaries with CBHMS (now Missions Door). Frieda also served on the staff of Nebraska Christian High School, then worked for the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association after moving to Minneapolis in 1977. She was active at her church, Powderhorn Park Baptist Church. She particularly enjoyed singing in the choir, serving in women's ministries and teaching English to Hmong immigrants.
