Ambrose Wallace LaBlanc was born in Fargo, North Dakota on May 28, 1938. His parents were Walter Cyprian LaBlanc and Viva Marie (Motschenbacher) LaBlanc. Ambrose was currently living in Rochester, Minnesota and he was a longtime Minneapolis resident. Mr. LaBlanc was the facilities manager for First Covenant Church in Minneapolis for many years. Ambrose was an avid bicycle rider – who knew the art of bicycle commuting and touring. He also worked for Sims Security for Twins games at the Metrodome Press Box. He was a serious Twins Fan and collected a small hodge-podge of memorabilia over the years. For the last year or so, Ambrose spent his mornings, Monday through Friday, greeting people on the corner by the Mayo building in downtown Rochester. His goal was to help people start their day off right. His daughter Paula had encouraged him to volunteer, and so he came up with his own special way to help people. One of the Mayo employee magazines wrote a full page article about Ambrose. He passed away on Friday, September 4, 2010.
