Beryl then attended Northwestern Bible College in Minneapolis studying to become a missionary. Following graduation she was sent to India by the Baptist Church where she served for more than 38 years. She passed on her love for the Lord to all who knew her. She made many life long friends on the mission field and among the people of India who still correspond with her. Her stories are myriad and examples of her courage, faith, and love for all she served. In 1945 during WWII she traveled to India by British troop ship and on another occasion some years later by a loaded cattle boat.

Upon her retirement she just changed her venue and ministered to everyone she knew. She taught Bible studies, English to immigrants, belonged to the Women's Guild of First Baptist Church (Minneapolis), and was a leader of the Ambassador Club.
